centers and distribution companies in 7 countries, it operates in over 50 countries and has c. 840 employees (900 a year ago). Ferro's business is highly diversified, both geographically and in terms of the product offer.

**Key points** 

**Business model.** The Group owns 4 logistic

In 1-3Q23 (i) products and goods constituted 33% and 67% of the Group's sales, respectively, (ii) the contribution of the segment of batteries and accessories/ the installation fittings segment/ the heating systems segment to sales stood at 48%/ 35%/ 15%, (iii) 73%/ 27% of sales were realized in the traditional/modern channel, (iv) 40%/21%/ 18%/ 6%/ 4%/ 1%/ 10% of the Group's sales came from Poland/ Romania/ Czechia/ Slovakia/ Hungary/ Lithuania/ other countries.

- **Drivers.** The demand for the Company's goods and products is driven by the development of the housing market in the region. In the installation fittings segment, the replacement demand constitutes c. 55% with c. 45% stemming from new investments. In the segment of batteries and accessories, 80% of demand results from renovations and 20% from new housing investments. The acquisition of heating business increased the Group's dependence on the primary market.
- The strategy. According to the Company's management estimations, the implementation of the F1R2 strategy (without acquisitions) will allow Ferro to generate PLN 1,400 million and PLN 193 million of FY26 revenues and EBITDA, respectively, with annual capex not exceeding PLN 30 million. Our FY26 forecast assumes lower top line and EBITDA (at PLN 1,137 million and PLN 161 million, respectively). The Strategy F1R2 assumes a dividend payout in the amount not less than 50% of the Company's NP in the

■ 4Q23E. We expect slightly lower revenues and net profit than in 4Q22 with somewhat higher EBIT margin. The results under the impact of the weak demand should be positively affected by low prices of freight, raw materials, and more favorable FX rates (3M aluminum/zinc/copper prices in PLN were by 3%/ 7%/ 9% lower yoy at the end of 3Q23).

At the end of 3Q23 the Group's inventories stood at PLN 283 million (down 22% yoy) and the net debt totaled PLN 133 million (down 30% yoy). It seems that the inventories can be further optimized. ND may grow due to a dividend payout in October (PLN 32 million).

- FY financial forecasts. We update financial forecasts for the Company, mainly with respect to capex and inventories. Ferro revised capex to PLN 25 million this year and below this level for 2024 (continued ERP implementation, development of technology and assembly facilities). The product offer optimization should help optimize the inventories.
- 2024 outlook. Though the situation on most markets, including Poland, is gradually stabilizing with the demand declines flattening, it is still difficult and we assume no quick improvement next year. The competition is strong. The stock levels in the sector are high. Due to uncertainty the order periods are materially shortened. The consumers are cautious, especially in the selection of heat sources. The demand for gas-fired boilers is still lower than in 2021 or 1Q22, albeit it rose in the previous quarter. High investment costs coupled with high energy prices are causing the stagnation of the heat pump business. A potential inflow of funds from the EU Recovery and Resilience Plan and support schemes for thermomodernization may exert some positive impact on the market, albeit it is limited at the moment.

Against this backdrop Ferro focuses on active price management, offer simplification, inventories optimization, and the EBIT margin improvement. Next year the pressure on wages growth and other costs (of marketing, services creation, exports development, etc.) may materialize, but further optimization of assets and employment (in logistics, for example) is expected. All in all, we hope for the results improvement next year.

- **Risk to financial forecasts.** High both ways.
- **Valuation**. Our valuation for Ferro increases under the impact of (i) the risk free rate revision (at 5.5%, previously 5.6%) in the definite forecast period, (ii) peer forward multiples update, and (iii) modification of our financial forecasts. Our 12M EFV constituting a 50%–50% mix of the DCF FCFF method and peer-relative valuation, increases by 4% to PLN 34.7 per share from PLN 33.3 previously. The DCF FCFF/peer-relative valuation yields PLN 40/29 per share (previously PLN 38/29 per share).
- Recommended action. In spite of difficult market conditions and recent launch of a warehouse (disruption of sales and costs in ST) the Group is doing well which, to a great extent, is helped by lower raw material prices and FX rates. We believe that from the strategic viewpoint launching the new warehouse is favorable for the Group as not only will this enable a revenues growth and faster penetration of South European markets, but also will curb costs streamlining logistic processes. We like the efforts to optimize the offer, inventories, and employment in the Company.

Please note that we also resort to other valuation techniques (e.g. NAV-, DDM- or SOTP-based), should it prove appropriate in a given case.

related to the residual value calculation. Assumptions used in valuation can change, influencing thereby the level of the valuation. Among the most important assumptions are: GDP growth, forecasted level of inflation, changes in interest rates and currency prices, employment level and change in wages, demand on the analysed company products, raw material prices, competition, standing of the main customers and suppliers, legislation changes, etc. Changes in the environment of the analysed company are monitored by analysts involved in the preparation of the recommendation, estimated, incorporated in valuation and published in the recommendation whenever needed.
